

GRAPE VARIETY

Cabernet Sauvignon

COLOUR

Brilliant deep red with a scarlet hue.

NOSE

Cassis, blackberry, red currant and fresh plums with bay leaf, cinnamon and tobacco.

PALATE

Elegantly structured and finely textured with outstanding complexity and persistence. Red and Black current flavours alongside cassis, coffee, chocolate and hints of tobacco leaf and green peppercorn

VINEYARD REGION

Margaret River 95%, McLaren Vale 5%

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The 2020 vintage in Margaret River was marked by persistent warm and dry conditions. A drier than average Winter and little to no rain in the preceding Spring resulted in a high quality, low yielding crop. The drought conditions brought the harvest forward two weeks earlier than the long-term average. Average temperatures throughout summer provided ideal harvest conditions resulting in wines with fresh flavours and bold tannin structures.
