#### HRB

## **GRAPE VARIETY**

Riesling

### **COLOUR**

Pale Straw with green hues

## NOSE

Orange blossom, lemon zest, notes of white peach with underlying jasmine flower and a mineral accent.

# **PALATE**

This wine has dense layers of fresh citrus and stone fruit along with floral notes and perfect acidity. The wine is fine and delicate with a persistent finish along with stunning minerality.

## **VINEYARD REGION**

Tasmania, Clare Valley, Eden Valley

#### **VINTAGE CONDITIONS**

The 2021 Vintage in Tasmania saw good yields and exceptional quality. The Clare and Eden Valleys also had good 2021 Vintages which resulted in a beautiful wine with great balance and minerality with the stone fruit notes coming from the Tasmanian portion of the grapes and the citrus blossom and minerality being brought to the wine from the Clare valley and Eden valley grown grapes.
